The Stevenson School for Ministry Learning Weekend

is designed to guide us to a richer and deeper prayer life. Our theme, “How to Pray About The Broken Places of Our World,” is inspired by Bishop Scanlan’s recent blog, “How to Pray About This,” and is designed as a follow-up to the August learning weekend’s theme, “How to Heal a Broken World.”

All are welcome to engage in this power of prayer weekend and discover stories of how to pray, stories of prayer and healing, and how people manage in turning from a broken system to a way of healing, from a life of pain to a life of wholeness and from inadequacy to fulfillment.

Participants will also have the opportunity to measure their readiness for deepening prayer by using the Intercultural Development Inventory Assessment® (IDI®). All tools offered throughout the weekend will help deepen prayer life and build community.

The Rev. Dr. Allison St. Louis was Director of Contextual Ministry and the Second Three Years Program at Virginia Theological Seminary. She has been a Spiritual Director at VTS and a staff member of the Episcopal Preaching Foundation’s Preaching Excellence Program.

Sessions include “Discovering Your Spirituality Type”; “Spiritual Practices: Listening for the Holy Spirit” (led by Deacon Marsha Roscoe, Associate Dean of the Stevenson School for Ministry); “Deepening Your Parish’s Prayer Life”; “Corporate Prayer Practices” (led by The Rev. Richard Jorgensen), and the Intercultural Development Inventory® (IDI®) (led by The Rev. Canon Dan Morrow).
